

Online check-in: What is it? - Lufthansa

Lufthansa German airlines make it possible for their passengers to check in online. This type of check-in is not mandatory and is one of many options provided by the carrier.

How to check in online with Lufthansa? After online check-in is opened by the carrier, we will send you an email and you will be asked for information required to create a boarding pass.

Online check-in with Lufthansa

What information is required when checking in online

Lufthansa Airlines require certain information that is necessary to create a boarding pass and allocate a seat on a plane. It includes:

- date of birth,
- nationality,
- travel document type (identity card or passport card),
- identity card number,
- country of issue,
- date of issue and expiry date,
- visa, if required in the country of arrival (e.g. the United State of America).

The document containing information given when checking in online should be brought to the airport and produced during boarding.

No online check-in option

Lufthansa Airlines require certain information that is necessary to create a boarding pass and allocate a seat on a plane. It includes:

- Burgas (BOJ),
- Bastia/Corsica (BIA),
- Fort-de-France/Martinique (FDF),
- Eilat (VDA),
- Paphos (PFO).
